british east india company after general distrust and dissatisfaction with company leadership resulted in a widespread mutiny of sepoy troops in 1857 web british empire the rise and decline of the britain enjoyed profits of industrialization relatively easily web the british empire was transformed into the commonwealth in which numerous states gained independence but voluntarily associated with great britain luscombe however the legacy of british colonialism left a lasting impression on many parts of the world leaving the former colonies politically economically and socially unorganized web british rule in ireland spanned several centuries and involved british control of parts or entirety of the island of ireland british involvement in ireland began with the anglo norman invasion of ireland in 1169 most of ireland gained independence from the united kingdom following the anglo irish war in the early 20th century initially formed as a dominion web 6 mar 2019 coming back to the the sovereignty of the crown having ruled for three centuries its imperialist tendencies had started to show quite early in the 17th web victorian era imperialism definition one of the crucial features of queen victoria s reign was the rise of imperialism by great britain great britain during this time not only emerged as the most powerful nation but by the end of the 19th century almost web the british empire was at the height of its power and influence in the 19th century between 1815 and 1914 britain became a global power with military and economic dominance the british empire occupied a quarter of the world s surface and included over 80 territories it had been an empire made by private competing interests but ultimately it was britain s web british imperialism expanded its positions in the region of the near and middle east many states of that region that formally did not belong to the british empire for example the states of the arabian peninsula in fact were semicolonies of great britain
